Fort Lauderdale/Davie Campuses to Reopen

As you have already been notified, the FAU campuses in Davie and Fort Lauderdale were evacuated and closed earlier today. Thank you for accommodating us during this trying time. The health, safety and welfare of our students faculty and staff are of utmost importance to the University.

FAU took this action, in an abundance of caution, when our neighboring institution, Broward Community College, received a written threat. The Hollywood (Fla.) Police Dept. has informed the University that it has in custody a person of interest they believe may have knowledge of the threat. The investigation is continuing.

No security threats have been directed toward any FAU campus, and all classes and activities on all other FAU campuses are proceeding as normal.

The Davie and Fort Lauderdale campuses will resume normal operations as well, on Saturday, April 28. Final exams that were interrupted or postponed at the campuses have been rescheduled for Sunday, April 29. (See information below.)

Students who are unable to take their exams at the rescheduled times should contact their professors immediately to make alternate arrangements.
